

## Catch Up Funding 2020-21

When planning for pupil catch up, Edinburgh has a single approach to provision – ensuring all children falling behind in reading, writing and maths are supported to catch-up. For 2020-21, the Pupil Premium Plan is the single provision for all children who need additional support in these three areas. The total intervention spend for the year is £417,723. The total pupil premium allocation is £120,711. The catch-up premium funding is £37,200. There is an over-spend of £259,812.

**\*Children with specific needs in addition to reading, writing and maths, receive additional intervention as required and all children with an EHCP receive the support detailed in their plan.**

### Aim of catch up funding:

To close the gap of attainment for children falling behind

### The barriers to children's learning include:

Online learning – ensuring quality of accessible resourcing during the pandemic  
Catching up pupils that have fallen being due to not accessing intervention during lockdown

### The strategies to address barriers:

RWI to enhance phonic teaching  
Interventions for reading, writing and maths  
Speech link – an assessment and intervention planning tool  
MYON for online reading  
DHT support to ensure planning and resourcing is appropriate during lockdown  
Additional reading books  
Year six booster
