

## Edinburgh School Uniform September 2023

The Edinburgh School uniform is an integral part of our school life. By putting on the school uniform every day, children feel part of the school, remain smart, get in the right mindset for learning and during external educational visits, promote the school.

### SHOES

The biggest issue that has arisen this year is shoes. In line with our commitment to pupil wellbeing, no branded items are allowed-even if trainers have a black logo – for example, a Nike tick. No child should feel that they do not have the best branded trainer and for this reason, no branded shoes are allowed. It is also essential that no trainers have a coloured sole.

Trainers tend to be the item that causes most difficulty so for that reason, we are sharing this information in good time so that you can purchase your child's footwear. Please also note that no footwear should rise to the ankle or higher (including both shoes and plain trainers). Only shoes that rise to the heel are permitted.

Please find the uniform requirements which will be strictly monitored throughout the year.

Should there be any reason you are unable to provide this school uniform for your child or a medical reason prevents your child wearing the uniform, you must ensure you discuss the reason with school staff and provide evidence.

Standard grey trousers(winter) Standard grey shorts (summer) (not tracksuit or innoring bottoms)



White shirt with collar/white polo shirt



School sweatshirt/school cardigan with school logo

School fleece (for outside use)

### Swimming Kit



Year 6 pupils will need a full swimming kit to take part in their weekly lessons.

This consists of:

Long board shorts are not permitted by the leisure centre.

Black plimsolls for indoor PE (if your child does not have plimsolls they will be asked to work bare foot)



Black trainers for outdoor PE

### Drinks Bottles

As we are an Eco school please provide your child with a reusable drinks bottle. Glass water bottles are not permitted.



### Jewellery

Plain stud earrings only. No other jewellery is permitted.



### Hair

Long hair should be kept to shoulder length and tied back with a plain hair band.



### Other non-permitted items

Make up, hair dye, nail varnish and temporary tattoos are not permitted.
