

# EDINBURGH PRIMARY SCHOOL - RECEPTION CURRICULUM MAP – SUMMER TERM

## MATHS

In Maths we will be learning how to double and halve numbers. We will continue to learn about odd and even numbers and we will be creating increasing and decreasing number patterns. We will be looking in greater depth at a range of 3D shapes. We will be identifying features of clocks and making our own clock faces.

## LITERACY

We will continue to learn new sounds in phonics and to write words and sentences applying our phonic knowledge and read back our work. We will be expanding our sentences using a variety of conjunctions such as 'because'. We will be writing for a range of purposes including writing a factual booklet, writing questions and writing letters.

## UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will be talking about different occupations such as doctors, nurses, firefighters and police, thinking about the range of activities involved in different kinds of work. We will be exploring where different foods come from and tracing them back through the chain of production. We will be looking at farms, farm yard animals and their young.

## People who help us

**This half term we will be sharing our knowledge about different occupations and learning about the tasks involved.**

## COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will be speaking about factual texts, asking relevant questions and making relevant comments. We will be developing our own explanations by connecting ideas or events. We will continue to listen to a range of stories, retelling them and creating our own versions.

## EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

We will be creating symmetrical patterns and linking this to halving. We will be creating posters showing where different foods originate and linking produce to different animals and plants. We will be learning about origami and creating our own origami animals. We will be expressing ourselves through music by creating our own routines based around the tasks of different jobs. We will be acting in role performing the different duties of a range of occupations.

## PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will continue to talk about the importance of kindness and generosity. We will talk about the importance of helping others and how by working as a team we can accomplish more. We will be discussing the importance of taking responsibility for our actions and how to express our emotions in a positive way.

## PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be looking at a range of physical activities that are involved in a working day of different occupations and creating patterns of movement with a special focus on balance. We will also be learning a dance sequence and incorporating these patterns.

## CHARACTERISTICS OF LEARNING

Each term we are highlighting a specific strand of the COL, encouraging the children to develop greater awareness of how important our attitudes to learning are. This term we are focusing on making links. We will be developing an awareness of how we can bring ideas and understanding from our previous experiences and connect these to new learning opportunities.
